Rules For Travelling as an Unaccompanied Minor


It is important to understand the Qantas unaccompanied minor policy, if a child is traveling with their parents. Here is some important information about the unaccompanied minor reservation.

- Qantas Airlines applies unaccompanied minor rules for those who are under 12 years old and traveling without parents.
- You will need to fill out the Qantas unaccompanied minor form.
- Adult fare will apply if the passenger's age is more than 15 years.
- It will be subject to additional charges if minors need special assistance.
- If your child suffers from a serious illness, you will need to share medical documents with the airline representatives.
- The unaccompanied minor booking cost varies depending on the destination and fare type.
- The unaccompanied minor baggage allowance depends on fare & route type.
- Qantas unaccompanied minor booking can be done by connecting with an airline agent.

How Can I Book a Ticket For an Unaccompanied Minor?

Qantas Airlines provides you with simple options for Qantas unaccompanied minor booking. You can book through online, connect with the local office representatives, or at the airport. You will have to complete the unaccompanied minor booking form, it is compulsory to fill it.

The parents of the unaccompanied minor will need to meet all the eligibility criteria for minor booking.

International Flights and Australian Domestic Flights (less than 6 hours)				
Age on date of departure	Unaccompanied minors Qantas Eligibility			
Under 5 years	Not eligible - But the child can travel with parents or adults 15 years of age or old.			
Between 5 and 11 years	Yes, only selected routes			
Between 12 and 15 years	Eligible			

International Flights (more than 6 hours)				
Age on date of departure	Eligibility			
Under 6 years	Not eligible - But the child can travel with parents or adults 15 years of age or old.			
Between 6 and 11 years	Yes, only selected routes			
Between 12 and 15 years	Eligible			

Qantas Unaccompanied Minor Booking Requirements

If children are traveling alone, they will need to meet all requirements.

- · Children should be able to eat and drink without any assistance.
- As per the unaccompanied minors Qantas policy, the airline assistance may help open the packaging where necessary.
- Should be able to go to the toilet without any assistance.
- · Take the medicine on time if they suffer a serious illness.

Qantas Airlines does not accept some unaccompanied minors who are able to:

- If they travel on connecting flights.
- If connecting flights times more than 4 hours.
- Overnight connecting flights.
- If children are not able to eat and drink without assistance.

What Should You Keep in Mind Before Traveling?

You should keep in mind some essential things when your child is traveling alone for the first time.

- If your child travels alone for the first time, you should tell them about the trip.
- You must complete an Qantas unaccompanied minor form.
- The form must be completed with all required information.
- Before departing, a valid document must be in the child's hands.
- Parents must sign the unaccompanied minor form.
- If an unaccompanied minor needs to change their flight for whatever reason, you will have to connect with airline officials.

Traveling with Medicines

Qantas Airlines allows unaccompanied minors to travel with their medicine. If authorized doctors prescribe them, you will need to provide a child medical certificate that should be issued by the doctor.

- The child must be capable of taking medicine without any assistance.
- Must be able to take medicine at a specific time.
- You will have to inform the airline agent about your child's medicine.

Check-in Time

The airline will team check the child's details and identification. They will also check the details of adult passengers, who will receive your child at their final destination. You will have to arrive at the airport one hour prior to your check-in time if your flight is Australian domestic flights. If your final destination is international, you will have to arrive at the airport 2 hours before your check-in time.

Qantas Unaccompanied Minor Booking Fee

Qantas Airlines charges an unaccompanied minor booking fee; it is an additional fee that the parents will pay. The fee does not apply for travel on Qantas partner's flights to and from Longreach, Barcaldine, and Blackall.

Travelling Alone as a Young Passenger

Qantas Airlines allows travelers to travel alone as young passengers. But age restrictions will apply. Look at the points below; if you travel alone as a young passenger.

- Age must be between 12 and 17 years.
- The airline will not provide assistance.
- If your flight is canceled by the airline, they will provide you with an alternative solution to arrange your final destination as soon as possible.
- The airline will provide regular updates to parents.

As per the Qantas Unaccompanied minor policy, between 5 - 12 years a child can travel without his parents. But it is applicable on specific routes and needs to meet all requirements.

Qantas Airlines provides unaccompanied minor services for children aged 5 to 12, ensuring that they travel securely and comfortably under guidance from professionals. However, minor parents will need to complete all required documentation work.

Q3. Can 17 year olds fly alone internationally on Qantas Airlines?

Yes, on Qantas Airlines, 17 years old passengers can fly alone internationally as adult passengers. The fare rules will apply to them as adult passengers.

Q4. What age can you fly alone in Australia by Qantas Airlines?

Children aged 12 or more can fly alone with Qantas Airlines within Australia. Children aged 5 to 11 can also travel alone by using the Qantas unaccompanied minor service.
